



Hamden Public Library Volunteer Opportunities

Here are some things that you can do this summer to get some volunteer hours through Hamden Public Library:

- One book review (please see book review guidelines) = 1 hour of volunteer service
 - Remember: you can also submit book trailers that you have created.

- One social media post = 1 hour of volunteer service
 - Social media post examples:
 - Send in a #bookfacefriday picture for me to post on our Instagram
 - Send in a picture of your favorite book & favorite line from the book
 - Share @hamdenlibrary 's post on your own social media
 - Post about a program on your Instagram page or story (make sure to tag us: @hamdenlibrary)
 - Send in a 6 word book review to be posted on the library Instagram
 - Here's an example: "Hermione did all the hard work."
 - Send in a video to add to the library TikTok
 - Other - ask me and we can probably make it work!

- One act of kindness in the community = Volunteer service hours will be worked out between us so that we can make sure you get the time you put into a project.
 - Acts of kindness examples:
 - Decorate a kindness rock
 - Make a fleece tie blanket
 - Other - give me an idea and we can probably make it work!

- Community service in Hamden = I will match the time you spent on this service (but I might ask for proof!)
